The Premier's Reading Challenge has now closed. A grand total of 233 students completed the challenge for 2025. Completion certificates will be arriving at the school by the end of November.

Thank you to those students - and parents - who have supported once more this huge initiative. The PRC will return in 2026, so all those books read from November 2025 can be counted towards the next challenge.

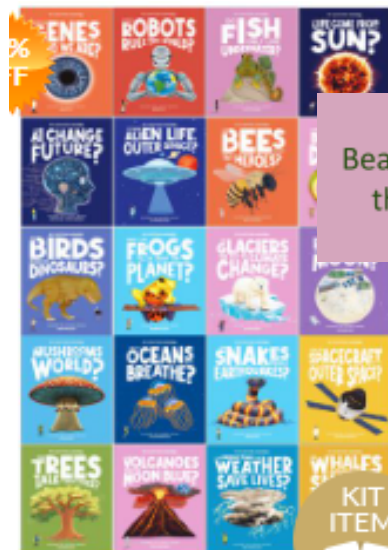

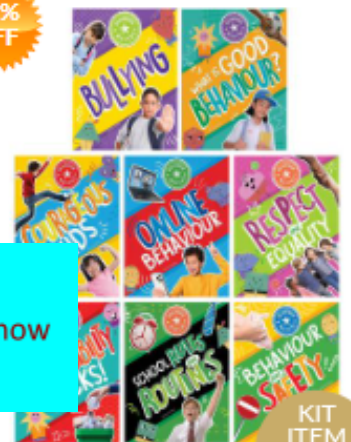
Continents of the World - 7 books:

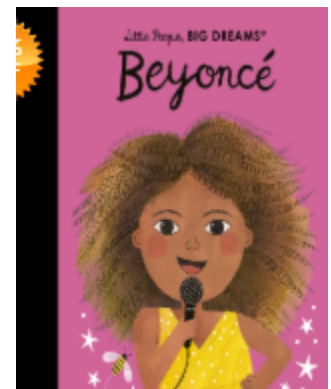

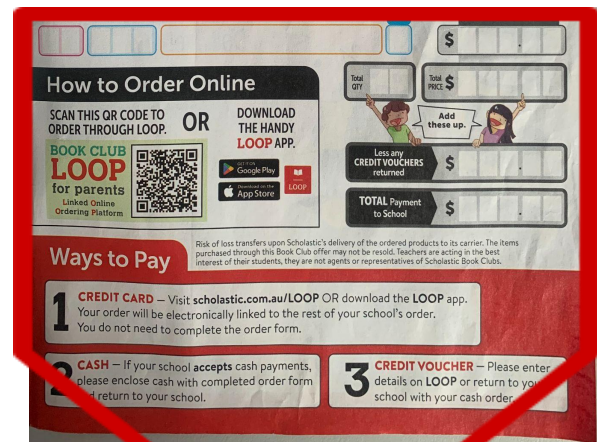
